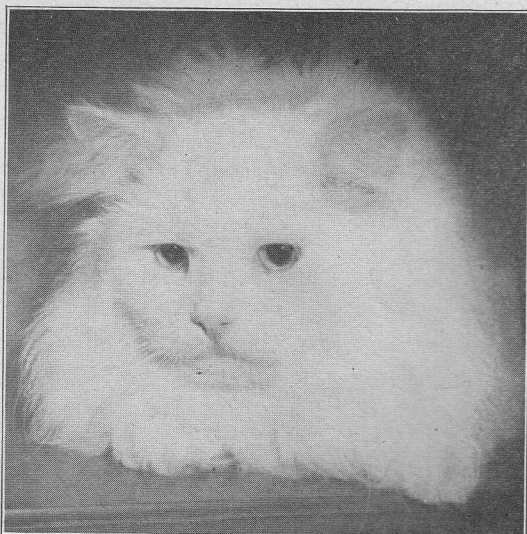

This season's shows are nearly over, and once more there are these who have won and those who have lost. As we look over the catalogs, we see many classes with one entry, which was awarded first and winner, and also best of color without competition. Many other cats winning third and fourth in classes of seven and eight entries, are better specimens, so why heap honors where they do not belong. Championships are entirely too cheap if they are given without competition. Why do not the three Associations adopt an adult attitude toward exhibitors, and insist that there must be at least four entries in a class to receive a winner's award, if not in one class between the male and female classes, and then only one winner to be awarded to the best of the four. Many entries of one in a class are not worthy of winners, and with competition could never win.

Is it not almost time that Americans have arrived at the point where, they can take a critique of their animals and learn wherein they fail. A published critique of a show would be much more enlightening than a marked catalog, showing one, two, three and winners, which really says nothing so far as the outstanding qualities of the animals are concerned.

Same Old Story

The same old story has arisen this year. There has been the trend toward transferring of chinchillas to shaded silver classes or vice versa.

At one show a cat is entered as a chinchilla, at next show it is transferred to shaded silver class. If there is not enough difference in the color between a chinchilla and a shaded silver to show a decided dividing line, why not put both chinchillas and shaded silvers in one and the same class.

At one show after judging four chinchilla males and awarding prizes, a class of three shaded silvers was benched, and after placing the awards, the judge remarked there were two classes of the same color. The exhibitors who make such shaded silver entries know their cats are too light for the class, but they take a chance, hoping to make win-

If the judges would mark such entries "Wrong Class" the owners would soon discover where their cats belonged. As there are so few cats one can really call shaded silvers, why do not the Associations abolish the shaded silver class altogether?

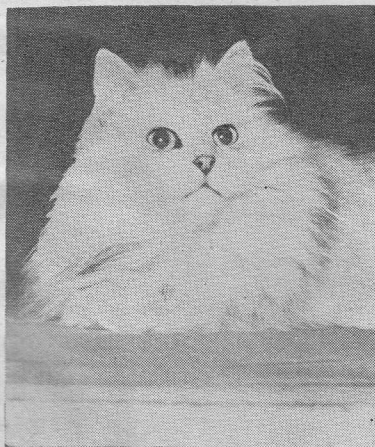
Some chinchillas are a little more shaded, that is tippings deeper in their first year or two, later fading into pale chinchillas, and in the meantime they are transferred from one class to another in the show room, thereby receiving awards which rightfully should go to the cats which have been entered in only one class.

It would be interesting to have the opinions of the silver breeders and the Associations on these subjects.

HARASSED HERON

A great blue heron, largest kind of bird native to Philadelphia and vicinity, put in a very bad night, a few weeks ago. First it was shot, then it was locked up in a guard-house in Fairmount park, transferred to the Zoo, and its wing was amputated.

Park Guard Robert Henry found the bird while making his rounds about 9 a.m. The heron, with one wing dragging, was unable to get away, and obviously it had been shot by a person or persons unknown. Guard Henry locked up his captive and notified Sergeant Arthur McManus who, in turn, got in touch with John Regan, head keeper of the Philadelphia Zoo. Regan was just going to bed

when the telephone rang. A few minutes later he was on his way to the park. The heron was turned over to him, but neither a taxi or trolley was in sight. Regan hiked back to the Zoo, examined his charge, and decided that amputation of the shattered wing tip was imperative. He performed the operation and his patient is now doing well.

The great blue heron measures 48 inches from tip of bill to tip of tail. It is built like a flying string bean. In summer it is a common resident of this region, but in the winter only a few remain north to brave the cold weather. The freezing over of small streams and ponds probably drove the bird to the shores of the Schuylkill where it might have a dubious chance of finding a meal.

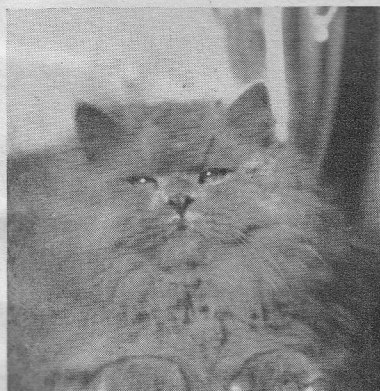
