"Sarisbury Simba" is the sire of Mrs. Langston's Flambeau of Allington, the lovely Chinchilla male I wrote about last time, who is now a full Champion.

"Sarisbury Simba" also sired the Best Opposite Sex Kitten, a lovely Chinchilla female "Snow White", so delicately ticked and of lovely color and type and huge eyes. Simba's was a very popular win, all three judges voting for him.

The Best Black was Mlle. Posthuma's "Chadhurst Gwenda", sired by Miss Rodda's Ch. Chadhurst Sambo, which cat was awarded Best Exhibit at our own Southern Counties Show in London on January 30th, an honor he well deserved. I think you may be seeing his son and daughter in America this year, same litter as "Chadhurst Gwenda" was in. This was "Chadhurst Gwenda's" first Challenge Certificate, she being only ten months old, a most attractive female.

Mlle. Posthuma's International Champion "Southway Wizard", brother of the famous Int. C. of C. Southway Nicholas, acclaimed "The most beautiful Cat in the World" at Paris in November last, won another Challenge Certificate and was Best Blue Exhibit.

I never saw so many beautiful Smokes in my life at one Show, thirteen of them, looking a perfect picture. This breed has been worked on very much during the past years and the results are excellent. Dr. I. J. Doeksen, the well-known Dutch geneticist is responsible and is very keen to improve it. His male "AMON

VAN DE NIJEHORST" won first and Champion, which Dr. Doeksen bred. The sire of the Best Kitten in Show, a really beautiful Smoke, "TARIJAN VAN DE NIJEHORST", was Int. Ch. Southway Wizard. A twelve year old cream. Ch. Jonathan of Shatterway—well-known English prefix—was Best Cream M, a lovely cat of purest, palest, unmarked color. The cream female winner was "Weddington Walaby" sired by Ch. "Weddington Warden" and bred in England. She came from France and was Best Cat from that Country and Best Cream Exhibit.

Verv big classes of Chinchillas were benched and Mr. Martin had his work cut out to separate them. "Sarisbury Simba" being First Ch. Male as I have already said and "Harestone Happy Cat" First Ch. female. She also was bred in England, Sire Ch. Rodney of Allington and bred by Miss Burgess.

Two lovely imported Siamese bred in England won First Ch. male and female, the Sire being "Larchwood Clover", a very lovely cat and owned by Mrs. Duncan Hindley, one of our best known Siamese breeders.

At our own Southern Counties Show "Ch. Mair of Allington", well-known blue owned by Miss Langston, was Best Female. She was a bit short of coat owing to insisting on feeding and looking after kittens for so long. She fostered some Chinchilla kittens, as when her own were born she had no milk in and they had to be taken over by a dear old short hair black, who was a devoted mother. Mair herself later insisting on taking these other kittens. She proved a very devoted mother. Her eye color is still amazing and with her big round eyes and beautiful, fair, sound, lovely color, she annexed another Challenge Certificate. She will again be mated this year to Ch. Southway Crusader.

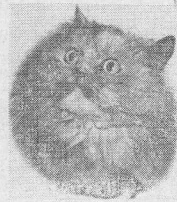
